Today we celebrate the Chinese New Year, also known as chūn jié (春节, the Spring Festival), which according to the Chinese lunar calendar marks the beginning of the Year of the Metal Ox.

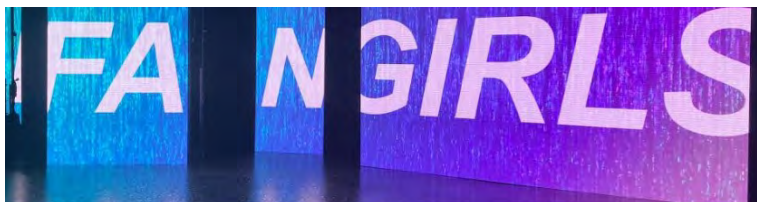
