Dear Parents,

What a wonderful time the children had during their Spring Vacation as they were transported away to the magical world of "Neverland". Whilst putting on a pirate's hat and eye patch or tinker bell dress, may appear to us mere play, for young children dramatic role play is very important for a young child's brain development. It encourages them to harness all the information they have already gained about a particular character, for instance that pirates sail in large ships, like to hunt for treasure, protect themselves with swords and as one little boy who limped his way into school last week explained to me, "I have to walk like this today because I'm a pirate who had a fight with a crocodile and now I have a wooden. Leg". Having the ability to recall and process information is an essential component of brain development and acting out real and imagined roles is beneficial to fostering this.

Dramatic play further helps children to confront their fears, for some children pirates or crocodiles may be scary, processing their fears through play and allowing them to gain control of a situation in which they control the outcome assists in this process. (I can assure you that I had many bad crocodiles sent to my office on our walk the plank day!)

The vacation period is always a lovely break for the children from their daily routines but we are now ready for an action packed Term 4. As advised our Specialist classes will be rolled out over this upcoming Term. Reddam requires that all Specialist Teachers are fully vaccinated and do not work across other schools or our other campuses. We began last week with Physical Education Classes and Piano and over the upcoming weeks MyGym, Drama and Mandarin will also resume. The teachers will display the schedule for these classes on their programmes which you will find at the entry to each of our classrooms.




